This brief is a requirement for all Marines who are first time TA users. Participants will review the Marine Corps TA policies and the local process for requesting TA.

GI Bill Brief

Explains the differences between the Montgomery GI Bill and the Post 9/11 GI Bill. In addition, Marines will learn all the advantages of each type of GI Bill and how they can apply for and use these benefits.

USMAP/MCCOOL Brief
