### Description:

Learn how to mat, mount, and secure a 5x7 picture with in a frame. First students go over shop safety, then cover how to choose your mat colors, set the margins, use the mat cutter and measure. Students learn different mounting techniques and how to close (secure the mat glass and picture in the frame and put the paper and hanger on the back). At the end of class they get a card that will allow them to use the shop whenever they wish for a shop fee of \$2.00 an hour.

## Advanced Matting

You will be taught two basic lay outs using pre set dimensions, mats and pictures/objects. In this class you will only cut the mats and mount the material (provided), we cover glass backing and closing a frame in the basic class. If you wish to learn how to join a frame the instructor will be available after class to teach any interested students (you will not be able to use our facility in the future for this, it is a free service provided to all in-house customers).

## **Description:**

Learn the traditional art of Ikebana. Ikebana is the Japanese art of flower arranging traditionally taught to young women as part of proper etiquette. This class is self paced for beginners and advanced. The first session will cover the basics (upright arrangement style), the second session will be the slanting style, third horizontal, and in the fourth class you will make a center piece. The centerpiece will teach Nageire (introduction to tsubo, or vase) and will also cover Moribana (center piece). As Ikebana has many schools and styles this class is offered in one month increments (four classes once per week) and can be taken continuously so you can receive a verity of instruction.

## **Description:**

Learn the sensational art of forming containers, bowls, plates, and much more on the potter's wheel. In this class you will learn the basics, anchoring clay to the wheel, removing air pockets, creating basic forms with your hands. In addition to the basics of forming a container students will learn how the clay dries and basics of the firing process. After their containers are formed and fired for the first time students will learn how to glaze their pieces and then have it fired an additional time to complete the process.
