Asian Spa “Kanna Thalasso”

The flowers are in bloom in Okinawa! Enjoy a beautiful day in Higashi Village. First we will go to the Azalea Festival then we will move on to Kaguya Hime Rose garden. Bring Yen for entrance fees, lunch and purchases.

Battle Sites

Visit the Battle of Okinawa Historical Society’s museum on Camp Kinser. Then relive the battle with a history lesson. Explore the Japanese Naval Underground Headquarters, and end the day at Peace Prayer Park. Bring dollars for lunch and yen for admission fees (Y750). Participants should wear comfortable, non-skid shoes and bring a hat

Eco-Fun Day

Come out and enjoy nature and take a few hours to relax at the Kurashiki Dam and Southeast Botanical Gardens. Take a leisurely stroll, feed the fish or make a craft. Bring Yen for Lunch buffet at S.E.B. and spending.

Expo Park and Churaumi Aquarium

Head to Expo Park where you can visit Okinawa’s four-story Churaumi Aquarium, the largest in Japan and the second largest in the world. Watch a free dolphin show, visit an Okinawan Village, or relax on Emerald Beach. Bring yen for lunch and purchases.

Forest Adventure Park

Island Transportation 101

Don’t have a car? Looking for a more eco-friendly way to get around? Join us for a guided tour of the Okinawa commercial bus and rail transit system. Master the basics of riding the bus and monorail while learning the etiquette of using commercial transportation. The tour will begin at a local bus stop, get off the bus at Kokusai Street, board the monorail and transit to the airport, get back on the monorail, shop at Kokusai Street for an hour, then ride the bus back to Camp Foster. Bring yen for lunch and smaller change for the bus. Local bus guide in English is included in the tour price.

Japanese Tea Ceremony

Enjoy the varied flavors of Okinawan cuisine buffet while being entertained by traditional music and dancers. Eisa Dance is performed by Zampa Daiko group at this one of the famous resort hotel in Okinawa. The tour price includes dinner and show. Bring yen for drinks.

Okinawa World & Himeyurinoto

Tour Gyokusendo Cave, and then enjoy an eisa drum show, a glass-blowing center, a pottery village, and awamori shop. Also, tour the reptile museum for an additional Y600. Park entrance fee is included in the tour price. We will also stop at Himeyuri-no-To to hear the history of the Student Nurse Corps WWII (entry fee: Y300). Bring yen for lunch and spending.

Park Fun

Get out and get some fresh air and have some fun. Visit Comprehensive and Wakematsu Parks. Bring a Pick nick lunch and Yen for spending.

Picasso Art Tour

The Urasoe Art museum is hosting an exhibition From Picasso to Warhol. There will be works from 41 artists to include 60 individual works of art. After the Art museum we will stop at the Naha Main Place San A for lunch and shopping. There will also be an optional stop at the Okinawa Prefectural museum. Bring Yen for Lunch, shopping and entrance fee for prefectural museum.

Princess Tenko Illusion Show

Witness the amazing princess Tenko and her world famous illusion show at the Okinawa City Civic Hall. Princess Tenko is known for her death defying feats and phenomenal stage presence. Visit Sachi’s Japanese Antique Shop. For additional fee and with a reservation, you can make your own Garden Geta Shoes. Enjoy lunch at British Wine and Tea Shop. Bring yen for purchases.

Tunnel Rats

We’ll explore numerous caves that served as bunkers and shelter during WWII. Included in the tour is a stop at the Battle of Okinawa Historical Society’s museum. Bring dollars for lunch. *Participants should wear old clothing and sturdy comfortable shoes and bring a hat, flashlight, and gloves.*

Savor the varied flavors of Okinawan cuisine while being entertained by traditional music and dancers. Choose from Okinawan or American menu when you purchase your tickets. The tour price includes dinner and show.
