Who can attend Comic Con Okinawa?

The main event is open to SOFA ID card holders, American and Japanese citizens. For all other country nationals, please contact the MCB Butler Base Pass Office at 098-970-7519.

Do I need a ticket to attend Comic Con Okinawa?

Although a ticket is not required to attend Comic Con Okinawa, FREE attendee wristbands are available to all registered attendees!

Should I bring cash?

While many vendors may accept credit cards, it is recommended to bring cash (¥ and \$). The nearest ATMs are located at Ocean Breeze, bldg. 5906 and The Spot, bldg. 200.
