



GRE® - Graduate Record Examination

The GRE® is required for entrance into most graduate level programs. The GRE testing program is divided into two separately administered programs, the GRE® General Test and the GRE® Subject Tests. Most students take the GRE® General Test. Check with your school to verify which one is required.
