

**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).** Review the FAQs if you have questions about SkillBridge.


**How to Apply.** Click Navy and explore the steps Sailors are advised to take to participate in a SkillBridge program.

Submit an inquiry and a representative from your respective service will contact you as soon as possible. **OR** Contact the Transition Office at the Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) for details on programs available in your area, transition requirements to participate in SkillBridge and additional employment support.

**Industry Partners/Employers** looking to offer SkillBridge training must be cleared initially by DoD. Once approved by DoD, training information is promoted on the DoD SkillBridge website and eligible Service members may pursue command authorization to participate.
