TPE Skillbridge Military Program Overview

Did you wake up in a warm bed this morning? Did you enjoy a warm shower? Did you, perhaps, heat water for coffee or make breakfast on your gas stove top? If so, then you recognize the value of natural gas to the quality of life we enjoy in this country. TPE provides the equipment that allows the Gas Company to remain the safest, most environmentally sustainable neighbor in the communities they serve.

TPE has instituted a military transition program offering Service members the opportunity to gain valuable civilian work experience through specific industry training and exposure. As a manufacturer of high pressure equipment used in the maintenance and operation of the nation's grid of oil, gas and gas liquids pipelines, the company is seeking general labor employees to help prepare, test, ship, receive, clean and repair high pressure pipeline rental equipment. We are also seeking general labor employees to assist with the assembly of natural gas and gas liquids recompression equipment providing the industry's first portable gas recompression solution to fully mitigate intentional emissions typically part of standard pipeline operations.

TPE is growing rapidly. The company's operations are based in Tulsa, Oklahoma. As of January, 2020 a single satellite service shop has been opened in Burgettstown, PA just outside of Pittsburgh. A second service shop has just opened in Temecula, California. Soon we anticipate opening additional facilities in Denver, the Northwest (Portland or Seattle areas), and the Southeast (potentially the Atlanta area). The business model includes establishing these service shops regionally, located near our oil and gas pipeline customer's facilities. Each shop will be led by a foreman and/or supervisor employed by TPE. That foreman will lead a team of mechanics and service technicians who will be charged with the maintenance and repair of recompression equipment; the job preparation, shipping, receiving, hydrostatic testing and overall maintenance of high pressure pipeline maintenance equipment (launchers, receivers, filter units, separators, pipeline vent silencers, pipeline flares) and execution of field labor at the pipeline facilities of our customers.

Participants in the TPE Skillbridge Program will have a high school diploma, be able to safely lift 75 lbs and pass a DOT drug screening. Qualified applicants will be self-motivated learners who actively seek opportunities to engage with TPE personnel and learn how to troubleshoot, deconstruct, reconstruct, maintain and assemble our portable gas recompression machines. The candidate will also seek or already possess a thorough understanding of the operational fundamentals of high pressure gas filtration / separation, high pressure pig launching / receiving, venting, and flaring. Program participants may be working either to assemble, test, troubleshoot and operate the ZEVAC portable recompression units or maintaining, cleaning, inspecting, shipping, receiving or hydrotesting pipeline pig launchers, receivers, filter units and filter/separators.

Certain certifications will be provided by TPE as needed to perform work for our pipeline customers including but not limited to: Abnormal Operating Conditions, Characteristics and Hazards of Natural Gas, Operating Gas Compressor Units, Bypassing Gas Mains and Services, Prevention of Accidental Ignition. The TPE Skillbridge Program participant will also be provided training and appropriate certification in forklift operation, industrial rigging, DOT vehicle operation up to 10,000 lb and the use of proper PPE.

Depending upon market demand, TPE may employ two 8-hour shifts providing more opportunities for Skillbridge Program participants. Each shift will be supervised by a TPE employee and under no circumstances will a participant work more than 40 hours per week.

Job Description: General Labor

Corporate objective: Provide the Safe, High Quality Labor required to facilitate equipment rental and Zevac manufacturing / assembly.

1. Candidate must be able to:
 - a. Load / Unload heavy pipeline rental equipment using forklift and overhead crane
 - b. Recognize and respond appropriately to industrial hazards in the workplace
 - c. Safely lift 75 lbs
 - d. Demonstrate industry best practices in safe and effective Industrial Rigging
 - e. Demonstrate basic knowledge of hand and power tools including but not limited to:
 - i. Tape Measure
 - ii. Torque Wrench
 - iii. Hand drill
 - iv. grinder
 - v. hammer
 - vi. Impact wrench
 - f. Demonstrate a commitment to delivering high quality results
2. Candidate must have the ability to work independently
3. Candidate must have the ability to direct third party vendors in the correct loading, unloading, packaging of TPE equipment and components.
4. Candidate must have a high school diploma and be able to pass a DOT drug test.
