AZALEA MOONLIGHT FESTIVAL

The flowers are full bloom in Okinawa! Spend a beautiful evening in Higashi village where you can enjoy the night walk through sweet scent of Azalea. Bring yen for spending.

BATTLE SITES TOUR

Visit Hacksaw Ridge, Battle of Okinawa Historical Society Museum on Camp Kinser, explore the Japanese Naval Underground Headquarters and end the day at Peace Prayer Park. Bring dollars for lunch and yen for admission.

BIOS ON THE HILL

Spend a day relaxing in a tropical forest park! Enjoy a boat ride while viewing the flowers, plants and wildlife native to Okinawa. See the majestic water buffalo up close and personal and even take a ride in a water buffalo cart.

Admission and a boat ride is included in the tour price.

Bring yen for food, fees for other activities and purchases.

EXPO PARK AND CHURAU MI AQUARIUM

Head to expo park where you can visit Okinawa's four story Churaumi aquarium, the largest in Japan and third largest in the world. Enjoy a free dolphin show, visit an Okinawan village and much more! Admission for park and aquarium is included in the tour price. Bring yen for lunch and spending.

FOREST ADVENTURE PARK

Zip through the Okinawan woodlands. Test your courage in the zip slide ride, the Amazon rope bridge, the Tibetan bridge or any of the other exciting courses. Children must be at least 7 years of age and 56 inches in height. A person over 285 lbs. are not allowed on the courses. Bring yen for lunch and spending.

JAPANESE TEA CEREMONY AND KIMONO DRESSING

Take a part in a traditional ceremony that includes preparation of the matcha, customary powdered green tea served around Japan. Discover the history behind the kimono and dress in traditional Japanese kimono. The tea house will provide a complimentary photo of your immersion into Japanese culture. After, we will travel to Naha Main Place for dinner and shopping. Bring yen for dinner and purchases. *Please bring or wear white socks, white tee shirt and leggings for women or shorts for men. Children ages (0-2) are not allowed on the tour.*

KONGOU HIKE, HEDO POINT AND OKUMA

Enjoy a hike and work up an appetite. After hiking, we'll have late lunch at Okuma. Note: Hiking is strenuous and is not recommended for individuals with health problems. Bring dollars for lunch and yen for other expenses.

NEO PARK AND PINEAPPLE PARK

Visit Neo Park and feed birds, monkeys, llamas and other animals. After lunch, enjoy the rest of the tour at Pineapple Park. Admission to Neo Park is included in the price. Bring yen for pineapple cart ride Y400 and spending.

PIZZA IN THE SKY AND NAKIJIN CASTLE RUINS

Visit the famous café restaurant "Pizza in the Sky" located in the hilly areas of Motobu town. Overlook the beautiful ocean view as you enjoy your delicious meal of pizza and salad. Afterwards, stop by the Nakijin Castle Ruins to learn more history of the Ryukyu islands. Bring yen for lunch and spending.

SEA ADVENTURE AND LUNCH BUFFET

Enjoy an explosion underwater of color without getting wet! Come and see all the cute and colorful fish at Busena cape in a 360 degree view underwater observatory. After, take a hop onto the glass bottom boat and see more fish.

Afterwards, you will be treated to a sumptuous buffet at the Okinawa Marriott Resort. Bring yen for other expenses.

SHRINES AND GARDENS

Explore Shikina-en, the royal summer home and garden for the Okinawan kings, then take lunch and shopping break at Kokusai Street. After you are rested and refueled, we will travel to Fukushu-en, a garden built by Naha's sister city in China. Finally, explore Futenma Shrine. Bring yen for entrance fees (Y600), lunch and other expenses.

TUNNEL RATS TOUR

We'll explore numerous caves that served as bunkers and shelter during WWII. Included in the tour is a stop at the Battle of Okinawa Historical Society's museum. Bring dollars for lunch. *Participants should wear old clothing and sturdy comfortable shoes and bring a hat, flashlight, and gloves. Must be 8 year-old to participate in the tour.*

URASHIMA DINNER THEATER

Savor the flavors of Okinawan cuisine while entertained by traditional music and dancers. Choose from Okinawan or American menu when you purchase your ticket. Bring yen for drinks.

VALLEY OF GANGALA

Looking for a new, fun place to hike? Not only will you enjoy the beautiful scenery but also a spectacular walk through caves. The hike will be approximately 80 minutes, so be prepared by wearing comfortable clothes and drinking water! Afterwards, have lunch at Okinawa World where you can eat while watching the eisa drum show. Must be 3 years old to participate in the tour. Bring yen for lunch and additional purchases.

WHALE WATCHING TOUR

Join us on a whale watching tour in the surrounding warm waters of the East China Sea. Watch these mammoth sized creatures surface around the Kerama islands as you enjoy the beautiful scenery and ocean breeze. This is an experience of a lifetime!
