*Until further notice, all III MEF/MCBJ personnel are required to wear a personal flotation device (i.e., snorkeling vest, skin diving horse collar, buoyancy control device or other device) when snorkeling or skin diving.

SEA CONDITION DEFINITIONS/CRITERIA

All Clear (AC): Wind speeds have been reported at less than 18 MPH (16 Knots). Locally assessed conditions are suitable for novice water enthusiasts intending to participate in the location's primary water activities.

Caution (C): Wind speeds of 18 MPH (16 Knots) or greater, including gusts, have been observed for at least 3 hours. Locally assessed conditions warrant that individuals participating in water activities have extensive experience both in the planned activity and at the location.

Danger (D): Wind speeds of 35 MPH (30 Knots) or greater, including gusts, have been observed and are to persist for at least 3 hours or during Tropical Cyclone Condition of Readiness (TCCOR) 2. Locally assessed conditions are dangerous and warrant restricting access to the water and removal of individuals from the water.

SECTOR LOCATION

West (W): East China Sea shoreline, Hedo Point (Northern tip) west down to Cape Kiyau (Southern tip).

East (E): Pacific Ocean shoreline, Hedo Point (Northern tip) east down to Cape Kiyau (Southern tip).
